

Capital Christian High School is a fully accredited WASC/ACSI college prep school. The summer school program at CCHS is a comprehensive program designed to offer current high school students from grades 9-12 high school prep courses or courses for high school credit as well as classes for remediation. Summer school is open to any high school student.

All CCHS rules and regulations are in effect during summer classes. The summer school dress code is expected to be followed and the closed campus policy is in effect.

Students are expected to dress appropriately and modestly. Clothing must completely cover the stomach, back and chest. No bare feet or excessively tight clothing, revealing attire including excessively short skirts, shorts or low cut shirts. Clothing with references to alcohol, sex, drugs, racism or sexism, sagging and or exposed undergarments are not allowed. Students may be sent home for violation of the dress code policy. A second violation can result in dismissal from the summer school program. CCHS reserves the right of final interpretation of these rules.

Students will need to bring a sack lunch or may purchase small snack items from the cafe at break.

Credit courses are designed for student advancement to meet the rigors and expectation of colleges/universities. Courses taken for credit need to be approved by the school administration and a recommendation for all students seeking courses for credit.

Prep/Review courses are designed for students to use to help strengthen their reading and writing skills as they prepare for the various subject areas for the upcoming year.

**Remediation courses are designed for CCHS students only. This gives students the opportunity to improve their grade to have a "C" or better in some classes: Alg. I; Geometry; Alg. II; Eng. 9-12; Bible 9-12.**

Attendance is taken daily. Students enrolled in courses for credit may not miss more than one day of school per semester if they wish to be granted credit for the course. If a student is absent, a parent is to call the attendance office prior to class time to advise the school of the reason for the absence. The student is required to bring a written note from his/her parent or guardian to the Student Services Office prior to being re-admitted to class.

Tuition amounts listed for each class do not include the \$25.00 application fee (non-refundable unless class is not offered). Tuition must be paid in full by June 6<sup>th</sup>. Admission can be denied if tuition is unpaid.

All applications and payment must be turned into the Student Services Office.

Classes are limited and enrollment will be based on a first come first served basis. Students will not be officially enrolled until tuition and fees are paid. CCHS reserves the right to cancel classes that do not have sufficient enrollment. CCHS students will have priority enrollment until May 16<sup>th</sup>. Open enrollment application will be accepted immediately and open enrollment students will be notified by June 6<sup>th</sup>.

Students will receive a class schedule in the mail or via email. On the first day of class, students should arrive 15 minutes early to confirm their schedule and class room assignment. Schedules will be posted on the Student Services window. Students will be responsible to purchase their own textbook(s) for their summer school class(es) and must come to class prepared with their own pens, pencils, paper and notebooks.
