Capital Christian School began the Educational Support Services (ESS) ministry in 1987 with the desire to see all students equipped to become successful, confident and independent learners and to discover their God-given gifts and talents. Understanding not all students learn and progress through traditional educational settings at the same pace or rate of success, ESS strives to provide students with the tools and skills needed to overcome individual learning challenges and to become both academically and socially victorious. ESS offers the following programs:

TUTORING: Students meet with teachers who provide support ranging from remedial math and reading to re-teaching of all academic areas, homework help, test preparation and organizational strategies.

Cost: Varies per tutor

ELEMENTARY LEARNING CENTER: Provides targeted help for kindergarten through 5th grade students who have special academic needs. Services include prescriptive learning plans, small group tutoring, specific instruction in language arts and math and assessment conferences. Help and resources are also provided to the student's classroom teacher to educate and aid them in teaching the student in the regular classroom.

Cost: \$250/month

Middle School/High School STUDY SKILLS LAB: Focuses on assisting students with effective learning strategies/study skills that will enable them to experience success in school. Services offered include smaller class setting for core subjects, individual and small group tutoring, classes in study skills, case manager intervention, support materials for parents and teachers, academic assessment and referral.

Cost: \$250/month

COACHING PLAN: This program assists students in developing skills and habits necessary for academic success. Students are held accountable to correctly use their school planner and learn time-management, how to complete and turn in school assignments/papers/projects on time, and how to organize class notes and other class materials, etc.

Cost: \$135/month

The DISCOVERY Center -

NILD Educational Therapy: This therapy was developed by the National Institute of Learning Disabilities (NILD) to equip individuals with learning disabilities to succeed academically. NILD Educational Therapy differs from tutoring in that cognitive and perceptual weaknesses are strengthened to support independent learning. This is accomplished in two or three one-on-one sessions per week with a specially trained NILD educational therapist whose approach is to stimulate areas of weakness in perception and cognition to help them function effectively. Cost: \$5,700/school year

SEARCH and TEACH: An early intervention program developed to meet the educational needs of young learners before they experience the frustration of learning failure. **Search** is a 20-minute individual test designed for 5- and 6-year-old students to discover and identify individual strengths and weaknesses in the readiness skills necessary for reading success. **Teach** is an early intervention program of 55 learning activities offered to individuals which address the needs revealed by **Search**. Cost: \$285/month

For accelerated learners, CCS Elementary School offers the following program:

COUGAR CONNECTION: An after-school program which meets once a week and is designed to meet the particular needs of children who excel at their grade level.

Cost: \$275/semester
