IMMUNIZATION INFORMATION AND CHECKLIST FOR SCHOOL ENTRY FOR KINDERGARTEN AND FIRST GRADE

Please be advised of the immunization requirements for children entering Kindergarten. THESE WERE NOT REQUIRED FOR PRESCHOOL, BUT ARE REQUIRED FOR KINDERGARTEN ENTRY.

Immunizations - California State Law and Capital Christian School require every child to be fully immunized according to the regulations of the State Health Department. A copy of your child's up-to-date immunization record **MUST** be on file at the school or your child **WILL NOT BEGIN SCHOOL.** Information regarding immunization exemptions for medical reasons or personal beliefs may be obtained in the school office.

First Grade Physical Exam - If your Kindergarten student must receive further immunizations, please consider completing the First Grade Physical Exam requirement at this time. California State Law and Capital Christian School require that each child, upon entering the first grade, show proof of having had a physical examination within the past eighteen months. The yellow Report of Health Examination for School Entry form should be completed by your physician and submitted to the school office.

A COPY OF YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORD WITH THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE SCHOOL OFFICE:

_____ **POLIO** - 3 doses required; **3rd dose must be given after the child's 4th birthday**

_____ **DPT** - 4 doses required; **4th dose must be given after the child's 4th birthday**

_____ **MMR** - 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella; **Both given on or after 1st birthday**

_____ **Hepatitis B series.** Series consists of 3 injections. May start school if the first dose of the series is given. Subsequent doses must be given on schedule.

_____ **Varicella** - 1 dose OR health care provider-documented varicella disease (chicken pox) or immunity. (Documentation on the child's immunization record, by your physician.)

Copy of County Birth Certificate - must be brought into Elementary office before child may start school.

A child will be considered fully immunized if he or she has received 4 doses of polio vaccine and 5 doses of DPT, regardless of the age at which the last dose was received.
