Early Education Curriculum

What is curriculum? It is the design of experiences and activities developed by teachers to help children increase their competence; it can be thought of as everything that happens with children during their time at school. **Curriculum is not** something that is purchased or workbooks. At Capital Christian Early Education Center, our curriculum guide provides for learning experiences that use methods derived from the ways children learn. Children learn by doing! They learn by using their five senses. Young children are full of energy. They move and touch and interact with materials, which are also known as "hands-on learning" experiences. In early education, children need to touch, handle, and discover for themselves rather than just listen to lectures or fill out worksheets. These early education learning practices are incorporated into the daily schedule of activities in all the classrooms. Please feel free to ask any of the teachers about how they are teaching and utilizing the curriculum guide in their class.

Preschool Accreditation
